

ARCHERY INSTRUCTOR

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This is an introduction to archery which teaches the fundamentals of the sport. Safety skills are emphasized as a major priority. Students are also prepared for higher level training. Classes take place one day per week. Each session of classes (winter, spring, summer, and fall) runs for approximately 9 weeks, depending on the Chula Vista Elementary School District's calendar. This is a great opportunity for the whole family!

The archery instructor is part of New Hope Community Church's after school team. He/she responsible for teaching all participants as well as maintaining and storing all equipment in the large storage bin adjacent to the instructional area. As a representative of New Hope Community Church, he/she is also required to use strong, positive interpersonal skills to connect and build strong relationships with parents and family members of participants.

WORKS WITH

The archery instructor works closely with the After School Director and is directly responsible to him for leadership and performance.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Prioritizes and understands how to ensure that all participants will have a safe and orderly instructional environment as the most important aspect of this activity.
- Understands and applies instructional strategies appropriate for children ages 8 adult.
- Understands and applies a coordinated instructional plan that is designed to build beginning archery skills and promote a love for the sport.

COMPENSATION

- \$30/hour for instructional time
- \$15/hour for prep time for set up, take-down, and storage of all equipment.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- As many as two classes per day are possible during the spring and summer sessions.
- There is opportunity to build and grow the archery program to multiple days during the week, depending on instructor availability and popularity of the class.
