Paul reminds us that we do not see as God sees, we see things IMPERFECTLY.
(I Corinthians 13:11-13)

How we see our life, affects how WE LIVE and how WE TREAT OTHERS.

We add God to OUR PLANS instead of begin apart of GODS PLANS.

How can we know God's Vision?

1. KNOWING God is knowing his vision

God is LOVE (1 John 4:11-16)

2. Praying and requesting to see His vision in every SITUATION and RELATIONSHIP

Ask for the love of God to be WITH US and IN US.

Seeing others through GODS VISION is the only way we will be able to love our brothers and sisters as we have been COMMANDED to do.

3. Be aware of when we need A FRESH vision.

- Our DESIRES can fog the mirror
- Our SHAME, GUILT and FEAR will cause us to want to fix it by cleaning or covering up the cracks.
